

## CHRISTIAN NATION

America was founded strictly as a Christian Nation. All of the documents of the founding fathers confirm this without disputing it at all. What concerned these early fathers was that no one denomination be chosen as an "Official Church". Thus the separation concept simply meant: Christian yes; specific denomination no.

6. Worship of gods made with human hands is not a tolerated religion.
7. Worship of heavenly bodies such as sun, moon, and stars is also not a tolerated religion.
8. Witchcraft and the occult are not tolerated religions.
9. Humanism including "we are all gods" is not a tolerated religion.

Freedom of religion includes the right of all Christians and tolerated religions to proselytize as much as they please both in private and in public. None, however have any right to use violence or any variation of "conversion by the sword".
